### Meet the Board A Quick Look at our Board Members.

**President:** Dick Hyde came to Johnston in 1947 and has lived here ever since. He graduated from Johnston consolidated High School, in 1950. Dick was in the Iowa Army Guard for 43 years and retired in 1992 where he held many positions, his last being the maintenance manager for the state of Iowa. Dick married Linda Danielson a 1953 graduate of JCHS in 1954 and had six children Julie, Stan, Brenda, Sharon, Steve, and Janet they all attended Johnston schools. Four of them still live in Johnston. He resides at 5559 N.W. 66<sup>th</sup> Ave. in Johnston.

Vice President: Wanda (McDowell) Slauson came to Johnston shortly after being born in 1931. Graduated from Johnston Consolidated High School in 1949. She married Russ Slauson a 1950 graduate of JCHS in 1950. In 1953 they settled in Grimes to raise their family. Over the years, she has worked part time at various jobs and volunteered with everything from Scouts to visiting nursing homes on a weekly basis. In 1994 we started attending the JSHS meetings where I enjoyed the fellowship and information. Now, I have the opportunity to serve as Vice President of the Board of Directors along with four other graduates from JHS.

Secretary: Jackie (Weatherspoon) Reineke was raised in Johnston and graduated from Johnston Consolidated High School in 1962. She attended the University of Denver where she received a business degree. She later became an educator, earning a Master's degree in teaching from Drake University and a doctorate degree in curriculum and instruction from Iowa State University. Jackie taught 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades in the Southeast Polk and Ames School Districts and was the Director of Curriculum for the Ankeny School District. Before her retirement she taught and advised elementary education students at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. Jackie and her husband Bob moved back to Iowa four years ago and currently reside in Johnston.

**Treasurer:** Dick Tarlton was born to Jack and Josephine along with a sister, Jackie, lived on Harlan Drive. Dick graduated from Johnston Consolidated High School in 1950. Dick was married to Beverly Wiles and they had two children Randall and Lynn. He worked for the Iowa National Guard at the U.S.P. & F.O. for seven years, in the oil business for twenty one, insurance and real estate fourteen and has been retired since 1995.

He currently lives in Clive but the property on Harlan Drive is still in the family after eighty five years. His folks built it in 1925 and it is now occupied by his grandson and his family.

Board member: Marilyn (Bauman) Finney: Marilyn Bauman Finney was born in her grandparent's home on "Ridge Road" overlooking Camp Dodge in 1931. She was raised on the farmstead on 70<sup>th</sup> AVE., riding the school bus for all 13 years of school, graduating in 1949. After Graduation she was employed almost 10 years as Secretary for the Iowa Farm Bureau in the claims Dept. Marilyn married Robert Finney in 1955 and they had a son and daughter. From 1967 until 1973 the Finney family served the Presbyterian churches in the outdoor Christian education. Marilyn served as hostess, registrar, business manager and all that is involved in food service for the camps. The Finneys returned to Iowa in 1994 and soon attended JSHS meetings at Crown Point. Marilyn is proud to say the original owners of the museum house were her grandparents John and Mary Bauman. Her father, Carl Bauman lived in the home until his marriage to Cecil Shiffer in 1921.


